In Person Meetings at Church

With the approval of the District Superintendent, we can now start to have in-person meetings at the church. For the safety of all participants, the VA Annual Conference has set the following guidelines that must be followed:

- Gatherings cannot exceed 50 people.
- Everyone who comes into the building must wear a mask.
- Everyone must read the questions on the Health
 Acknowledgement Poster before entering and be able
 to answer yes to each of the four questions.
- A greeter should meet people just outside the front door to ensure everyone has answered the health questions and is wearing a mask.
- Everyone must keep at least 6 feet between themselves and people who are not part of the same household. No hugs or handshakes.

In order to meet these guidelines, we are asking that everyone contact the church office to ensure that no other group has already signed up to use the church. Because of the social distancing requirement, most meetings will need to take place in the social hall.

 If chairs or tables will be used, please wipe them down with sanitizing wipes (located in the kitchen) before you use them. Gloves are also available.


- To maintain social distancing, enter through the double front doors and exit through the double doors in the Fellowship Hall.
