

#### **Return to In-Person Church**

As we move deeper into fall, the mornings can come with a definite nip in the air. With that onset of cooler weather we will begin in-door, in-person worship this Sunday, November 1. We hope to continue broadcasting the service to the parking lot and on Facebook Live for those who aren't ready for in-person church yet. **The service will continue to begin at 9:30 am.** 

Just a few things to remember:

- If you plan to attend the in-door service, please contact the office by 3 pm today! Everyone will need to wear a mask inside the building and maintain social distancing ... so no handshakes or holy hugs yet.
- Print out your song lyrics and bring them along if you have trouble seeing the screen, so you can follow along.
- Please check in with Jeff Ritchie at the food pantry door, proceed to the parking area and enter through the main door.
- Once inside, you will be seated in the sanctuary with the assistance of greeters. We will try to fill the sanctuary from the front to the back, skipping every other pew. Families with children will be asked to sit towards the back in case you need to exit the sanctuary. Families of the same household or "bubble" will be seated together.
- At the end of the service, please remain seated until an usher/greeter releases your pew to exit, beginning at the back of the sanctuary.
- There will be no nursery or Children's Church; however, our Children's Ministry is working hard to bring Children's Church in the near future. Activity packets will still be available.
- If you need to use the restroom, we ask that only one person, or family unit, enter at a time. There will be disinfectant wipes available to use to open the door.

We know this will be a challenge and a little inconvenient for everyone. Please have patience with us as we tackle the logistics of in-person worship, while complying with the UMC conference regulations. We are happy to be able to hold in-person worship ... even though it will look a little different ... okay, a lot different. But, best of all, we are very excited to see you there!!



Daylight saving time will come to an end on Sunday, Nov. 1, so remember to set your clocks back on Saturday night, and it's also a good time to check your smoke alarms to make sure they are working properly.
