From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Beloved Siblings in Christ,

July is upon us, which means the 4th of July, fireworks, and campfires are too upon us. As we celebrate our nation's birthday and the heat ramps up, summer is certainly in full swing. July also marks the one-year anniversary of being your pastor, which is crazy and beautiful at the same time. I am incredibly grateful for you all; who gave me, the now 26-year-old pastor, an opportunity to lead you and Bethany into the future. It certainly has not been a flawless year and we have let some things get in the way of loving people and spreading the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ; BUT we persist forward. We have welcomed a number of new families. Some old faces have returned to our warm, and loving sanctuary. We have worshipped together outside of our walls, and have continued to emphasize our love for the people in our community. We have been the hands, feet, and smiles of Jesus, and that truly is a blessing. Ultimately, as your pastor, I am so pleased, grateful, and honestly overwhelmed what this community continues to do.

The month of July also has become a more difficult month for me in the past three years. As most of you probably know by now, in July 2020, I was shot in the stomach in a drive by shooting, in Durham, NC. In the first three days afterwards; I underwent three emergency surgeries to fix major organs; including my spleen, large intestine, and kidney. In this process, I needed 58 pints of blood to survive this ordeal. From the day I woke up and heard about all the extraordinary measures that were taken, I decided I would not live one day with any regrets and at some point; I would give back all 58 pints of blood, that I drained. I have been waiting to be able to host a blood drive in hopes to be the same saving hand, that I needed in my season of crisis. With all of that being said, I am incredibly grateful and excited to announce that Bethany UMC will be hosting a Red Cross Blood Drive on Saturday September 9 from 9 am-2 pm. IF you can give blood, make sure to sign up online or in the narthex. IF you cannot give blood, no worries, we will have more opportunities to serve that day and we need volunteers!

As we look forward to the next year together, I hope you will continue to pray for our church, our community, and our world. I hope you will find a new place on one of our many different committees and volunteer for one of our many upcoming ministry opportunities. Bethany is stronger, better, and more faithful because of YOU. So sign up, show up, and continue to be the faithful people of God that I have witnessed you to be in the past year.

A True Miracle by Gail Reese

It was Memorial day 2011 when I got a phone call from my gynecologist, Amy Keats. She called to tell me that my test results had gotten lost on her desk. She told me I had stage 2, phase 3 uterine cancer. It was a real gut punch.

Pastor Brad McMillan visited and prayed with my family. Before he left he asked if there was anything he could do for me. The verse from James 5:13-15 popped into my head. I asked if he could have the elders pray for me. He called together members of my Bible study and others. Two days before my scheduled surgery Ralph and I and ten other people arrived at the church. There was Pastor Brad, Pat Lamb, Bev Roller, Dot Roller, Jean Dunsmore, Terri Shifflett, Becky McCarty, Chuck McCarty, Becky Hawkins, and Kathleen (Pollock) Stump.

What followed was truly a miracle. We gathered at the front of the church. I was surrounded by my eleven saints. They laid hands on me and Pastor Brad prayed. I felt a weight lift off of me. Becky who was standing in front of me told me afterwards that as they prayed my face was "transformed". I felt the peace that passes all understanding.

As Ralph and I were driving home I realized my pain was gone. I told him I thought I was healed. I asked him if he thought going through with the surgery would be a lack of faith. He nonchalantly told me I no longer needed all those things. I went through with the hysterectomy. Interestingly, when Dr. Duska tested a lymph node no cancer was found. Then they tested an ovary and again no cancer was found. Finally they tested the uterus itself and only a few abnormal cells were found.

Praise God and thanks to my saints who prayed for me. That was now twelve years ago. Now I know if I had not gone through with the surgery there would not have been proof of my miraculous healing. It's not lost on me there were twelve people gathered and I am telling this story twelve years later. My God is a God of numbers and I believe a sense of humor!!





