



Financial Update by Cindy Kite

Yep, fall is officially here! Cooler weather, leaves changing colors, sweaters, college football, and pumpkin-spice flavored everything! Take time to enjoy this special time of the year and all the beautiful colors of fall! God painted us a beautiful canvas of breathtaking colors. Even if you're a summer person like myself, you have to love and appreciate fall just for the beauty.

On to finances ... as you can see by the chart, we are currently behind our projected budget by \$18,628.72. Yeah, it looks like a lot! If we challenge each other to increase our giving just a little, or start giving just a little, so we can catch up, and can maybe even exceed our projected budget of \$225,467.00! Wouldn't that be awesome! I know EVERYTHING is increasing in cost, from paper for the office to our oil and electric bills. But I also know my Bethany family and I know you'll do everything in your power to help us catch up by increasing your giving by a few dollars each week or month or just a one-time gift to catch up on those Sundays you missed.

I know you've been asked to give a lot during the past few weeks; however, keeping the giving up allows us to keep doing what we're doing!! None of it can happen without you!!

Congratulations!! With your generous giving to fund our part of the Honduras mission trip that Pastor Blaine and Gary Lucas went on, you met and exceeded the goal we were hoping for. The total collected was \$3,556.25!! You also contributed a total of \$3,978.76 through the "Kiss a Goat" contest. We were just shy of our goal of \$4,115.21 by \$134.45. All proceeds from the "Kiss a Goat" contest will go to the Capital Building Fund. If we count all of the donations made to the Capital Building Fund this year, including the "Kiss a Goat" money, we gave a grand total of \$6,532.36. Thank you!! You came through once again! Bethany has such awesome people! And I love each and every one of you!!

Technology has changed a great deal at everything needed to show lyric slides, Bethany over the years. I remember the days where there was only the soundboard. There were no extra lights, no cameras, and the recording of the service was done on cassette tapes. Later, we switched to CDs. In 2007, we began to put up lyric slides. COVID necessitated the video recording of services and Facebook feed, which was implemented by Dani DeHart and Dale Roller.

Today, with the construction skills of Bill Kile, Mark Dunsmore, and Donald Michael, we have a beautiful technology booth with room for

record the service, and soon, monitor the sound. Eventually, a powerful camera will be mounted that will take the place of both the current camera in the back and the camera in the aisle toward the front. We will continue to record the service and post it on the church website at mybethanyumc.org. At some point, the light stands in the front will be replaced with something less conspicuous. It's all a work in progress and it is very exciting to experience the improvements.

Our current technology team consists of Mark Dunsmore, Kristen Kile, and

Donald Michael on sound, and Maggie Huffer, Laura Lucas, and myself showing the slides and recording the services. If you are interested in being part of the technology crew or would simply like to sit in the booth and observe what we do, you are welcome. Maybe you'd like to have a try at clicking through the lyric slides, which is just a matter of pressing the "down" arrow to get to the next slide. The team certainly welcomes any help. Just come and talk to me if you're interested.


