From the Pastor's Desk

Bethany Family,

Summer is upon us. Which means the shorts have become a wardrobe staple, the vacations are starting to ramp up, and the heat and humidity have made their way back into the Valley. One thing that I remember from my summers growing up, is that summer tended to be the



time where my own family's church attendance dipped. And why wouldn't it? My mom was a hard-working teacher, so the summers meant more sleeping in and less regular schedules; while all the kids were in camps, cross country practice, and other summer activities. And not to mention we usually would spend a week in Maryland visiting my dad's side of the family, and then a week in St. Augustine visiting my mom's

side of the family. So, I am fully aware of what can oftentimes be a church lull in the summer.

But something I would like to encourage the Bethany family this summer is to continue to be faithful to our church family, even when one's physical presence is not in the building. Maybe if you have children or feel called to lead them, sign up for the Children's Ministry Team, which will help facilitate learning and

fellowship activities for our children throughout the year. Maybe if you have a heart for our community or want to get to know some of our community, sign up for the Bethany Bridge Builders team. Maybe if you feel you need to be in a community of discipleship or need to surround yourself with faithful leaders of the faith; consider joining a bible study or our Sunday School class after worship.

As a pastor, I am fully aware that I am tasked to lead the church I serve faithfully. So, it makes sense that I am passionate about continuing the faithful legacy of Bethany UMC. I am also fully aware that I am only one person, and therefore I cannot do everything. I am also aware that there are many folks so involved here that they cannot take on any more responsibilities. So, if you find yourself looking for ways to get involved, please reach out to me so we can find something that fits your gifts and talents. One of the most beautiful things of being a Christian is that it is a journey that takes a lifetime when it comes to becoming more like Jesus. God calls us to lean into our faith and allow our faith to grow when we open ourselves to new ways of living out the Christian faith. So, that is my challenge and hope for Bethany. If we all can do this, this church family will continue to thrive and be the people that Christ has tasked us to be.

Cemetery Board

As we have reached the almost midpoint through our 70th Year Anniversary here at Bethany UMC, your Cemetery Board wanted to give a few reminders of who we are and what we do for the church. So, if you are new or unfamiliar with all that Bethany UMC does, we have two cemeteries in charge of maintaining and operating. Both cemeteries are where a number of our Bethany family members are buried. The Naked Creek Cemetery which is found at 271 Dices Spring Road, Weyers Cave, VA 24486 is where the old Naked Creek Methodist Church, was before they moved to where Bethany is now. The other cemetery we operate and maintain is the Pleasant Grove Cemetery, found directly across from the Pleasant Grove Church at 32 Summit Church Road, Weyers Cave, Va 24486. This cemetery is operated and maintained by Bethany, as that church merged with us in 1988.

So, what do we want the Bethany Family to know about the cemeteries. First, the Naked Creek cemetery has several plots available for purchase. A 5'x10' plot is \$500 and corner markers are \$200. If you have questions or are interested in purchasing a plot, please reach out to Randy Roller or Pastor Blaine. Pastor Blaine is always willing to speak to people about long-term planning and how to make decisions easier for their families. Secondly, the cemeteries are financially supported by gifts from those in our congregation and community. These gifts are essential to maintain the legacy of those who have gone before us and honor the lives of those who loved Bethany. Any gifts can be made out by check to Naked Creek Cemetery and dropped off with Cindy or to Randy Roller, who is the new President of the Cemetery Board. Thirdly, we are looking for two new members to join the Cemetery Committee. This is not a time-consuming committee as we meet twice a year and spend our time making sure all efforts to maintain and operate the cemeteries are being met. If this seems up your alley, please reach out to Randy or Pastor Blaine. Lastly, we would like to thank Don Truslow who has been the President of this Board for 39 years. His leadership and care for our beloved descendants truly is a remarkable and honorable feat, and we are grateful for all he has done.
