From the Pastor's Desk....

Dear Bethany Family,

I do not know about you, but I thought that Easter Sunday was such a beautiful and special culmination of the Lenten Season and then Holy Week! It is always such a special Sunday, celebrating the empty tomb, and I always enjoy seeing and meeting your extended family members, friends and neighbors, and so many wonderful folks. But did you know that the Easter Season is not just one Sunday? In fact, the Easter season reaches fifty days beginning with Easter Sunday and concluding with Pentecost! After Jesus is raised from the tomb, and meets Mary on that Easter Morning, he spends the next few weeks, appearing to his disciples, continuing to teach and instruct them on how to live in accordance with their resurrected and very much alive savior and friend! Mission Opportunities.....

Hygiene Kits for Annual Conference – We will be collecting kits through Sunday, May 25th. The church already has Ziplock bags so we only need the items for packing.

Hygiene Kit Materials

- One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches) No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- One washcloth No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- One comb -Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth. No pocket combs or picks. Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth.
- One toenail or fingernail clipper -No emery boards or metal nail files
- Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger) No Ivory or Jergen's soap. Do not remove from packaging.
- One adult toothbrush Do not remove from packaging. Personal advertising not acceptable.
- 10 adhesive bandages (³/₄ by 3 inches) Common household bandages acceptable

Friends of Barnabas Donation Jar- We will be collecting funds for our September Honduran Mission Team, leading up to our trip. This donation jar alongside the Christmas in July Yard Sale will be our big fundraisers. The team has to raise \$11,500 team funds which will cover the cost of supplies and medications for our neighbors in Honduras, throughout the week.
