#### From the Pastor's Desk....

Dear Siblings in Christ,

Somehow, someway, we have arrived at the end of my third year of serving as your pastor! I am so grateful for the ministry, the people, and this beloved community that has surrounded me with prayers, love, and support as I have woken up every morning, with the hope and heart to serve to the best of my God-given ability. That is not to say, that I have been a perfect pastor, as I am far from it. But it is to say that this community is one of love, and one that leads others to Jesus, and I am blessed to be a small part of it. The way you all have continued to welcome Ashley and I is not something I take for granted.

As I begin my fourth year of pastoral ministry, I have been reflecting on a couple of things. The first being that I hope by now, everyone who has wanted to know me better has had that opportunity. I want you all to know that I am always available to meet for coffee, ice cream, or a meal with you.
